STANDING COMMITTEES

- **Nominating** - solicits nominations for the elected offices of NHCAP.
- **ByLaws** - reviews the Bylaws, the Certificate of Incorporation, and applicable state and federal laws to recommend amendments as needed.
- **Membership** - mails membership applications to all members, responds to inquiries from non-members regarding membership, maintains membership directory, and updates NFPA concerning membership information.
- **Newsletter** - produces NHCAP quarterly newsletter containing articles re: local & national issues as well as information of NHCAP events and programs
- **Pro Bono** - coordinates programs whereby volunteer paralegals can assist attorneys and/or legal assistance agencies, acts as a clearinghouse for information relating to pro bono opportunities.
